## 'Sport Makers'

Wharfedale Activity Group is holding a free workshop at llkley Rugby Club on Thursday 16th February 6.30pm –9.30pm to encourage people to organise and lead sporting activities.

Wharfedale Activity Group is encouraging people aged 16 and over to get involved and show groups how they can encourage more people to access their club, increase participation and gain some recognition. It is working in partnership with West Yorkshire Sport and Bradford Council's Volunteers in Sport project.

The project is helping to build an Olympic legacy throughout the Wharfe Valley.

As well as having the chance to be involved with the Olympics locally, the workshop will give people support and ideas.

Participants will receive a free Adidas tee-shirt and bag and a certificate after the completion of ten hours volunteering. They will also be entered into a draw for Olympic tickets and will have the opportunity to learn new skills or take further qualifications.

Sport Makers is part of the National Lottery's Places People Play legacy programme that is bringing the magic of a home Olympic and Paralympic Games into communities across the country.

• Organise a fundraising event for your village with the help of other Sport Makers


• Create a sport event or festival with other people for your local community
